STEP 2: Change URL's to your URL's. In the code above, there are two URL's that need to be changed.

STEP 3: Create a new folder and call it "objects." Or you can simply use your image folder.

STEP 4: Now, right click on the "share this page" images. Save the images one by one to your "objects" folder or your "image" folder.

STEP 5: Create another folder on your website and name it "help".

STEP 6: Create a new web page and name it "whats-this.html".

STEP 7: Copy and paste the following html code into "whats-this.html".

<em>bookmarking</em> services, like StumbleUpon, Yahoo! Buzz and Delicious, where you bookmark Web pages you like and

<p>Social media also let you tailor the Web to suit the way <em>you</em> prefer to use it. Some of the ways you can

on its button. Once your
account is up and running, you'll be able to share the Web page with friends and
family, or save it for later
reading.</p>

<p>Of course, you're not limited to the buttons you see here. You can use any of

Web page from <strong>www.your-own-website.com</strong> to the service you
already use.</p>

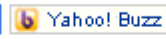
